



Grant Criteria:

Grants will be considered for **FY2023** programs or projects under the supervision of the **Catholic Schools Office** and **Evangelization & Family Life Office**. Programs and projects must align with the Pastoral Vision of the Archdiocese of Omaha - *One Church: Encountering Jesus, Equipping Disciples, and Living Mercy*.

Programs and Projects will be prioritized based on the following:

- It aims to create a culture of encountering Jesus and equipping disciples
- It seeks to create a culture that enables God's mercy to be received and lived
- It fosters a culture of unity

Grant Application Instructions:

1. One online application will be accepted for review per parish or school or religious education program. [Click to apply!](#)
2. Only **online forms** will be accepted.
3. Do not send additional program/project attachments.
4. Grant awards will not exceed \$2,000.

Applications are **COMPLETE** if they:

- Include a contact person, project/program name and description.
- Include itemized cost components.
- Include required signatures of endorsement.
- **Submit by Friday, April 29, 2022**

Types of Projects/Programs Funded:

- Incentive grants for the establishment of new educational ministries in parishes and schools
- Retreats/workshops for adults
- Retreats/camps for youth
- Retreats for parents with children
- Vacation Bible School / Totus Tuus
- Leadership/Stewardship conferences

Project/Program examples:

- Staff development/student recruitment/ministry training/youth leadership/RCIA/school reading programs and activities/family faith formation/transportation for students to activities/speakers/facility/resource materials/project supplies/certifications/registration fees

Non-Funded Items:

- Salaries, memberships, any tuition assistance or scholarships, textbooks, media resources, construction/remodeling costs, furniture, computers and equipment, chasubles/stoles, party costs/lodging/food, advertising/postage, any type of insurance or security services.

2022 Grant Schedule:

March: Grant cycle opens! Click [here](#) to apply online!

April 29: Deadline to submit online application – April 29, 2022

May: Grant Selection Committee meets to select grant recipients

June: Notification of their grant status sent to all applicants

July: Grants are awarded. Funding will be payable to the parish or school

July-August: Sign and return Acknowledgement of Receipt form upon receipt of funds
