## 2022 Parish and School Grant Summary Report

The Catholic Futures Foundation of Northeast Nebraska provides grants to parishes, schools and ministries of the Archdiocese of Omaha that can be used to expand, enhance and make accessible opportunities that directly affect the educational mission of the Church.

The grant program began in 1980 and grant awards are made possible by donor support of the Foundation's grant funds. Through the years the program has awarded more than \$1.2 million to nearly every parish and school of the Archdiocese of Omaha.

Funding for the Grant Program is supported by the annual distribution of these funds:

- Fund 285.400 Sr. Helen M. Spengler, OSM Endowment Fund
- Fund 280.000 OAEF Grants Fund (Board Designated Funds)

As of December 31, 2022 the current market value of these funds are \$30,083.98 and \$574,103.75, respectively.

### Priorities

Programs and projects must align with the Pastoral Vision of the Archdiocese of Omaha – One Church: Encountering Jesus, Equipping Disciples, and Living Mercy.

Prioritization of projects is based on the following:

- It aims to create a culture of encountering Jesus and equipping disciples
- It seeks to create a culture that enables God's mercy to be received and lived
- It fosters a culture of unity

Approved program areas to be funded includes:

- Incentive grants for the establishment of new educational ministries in parishes and schools
- Retreats/workshops for adults
- Retreats/camps for youth
- Retreats for parents with children
- Totus Tuus / Vacation Bible School
- Leadership/Stewardship conferences

Project examples from past grants requests are as follows:

Staff development/student recruitment/ministry training/youth leadership/RCIA/school reading programs and activities/family faith formation/transportation for students to activities/speakers/facility/resource materials/project supplies/certifications/registration fees.

Items not approved for funding:

Salaries/memberships, any tuition assistance on scholarships, textbooks/media resources, construction/remodeling costs, furniture, computers and equipment, chasubles/stoles, advertising/postage, any type of insurance or security services.
