Introduction to Theology of the Body - Session Schedule

Materials: An Intro. To the Theology of the Body student workbook.

Schedule:

• Mon, Sep 11 Session 1 – An Education in Being Human

• Fri, Oct 6 Session 2 – The Great Analogy of Spousal Love

• Wed, Nov 22 Session 3 – Man & Woman He Created Them (Our Origin)

Thu, Dec 22 Session 4 – Man & Woman He Redeemed Them (Our History)

• Fri, Feb 2 Session 5 – The Resurrection of the Body (Our Destiny)

• Tue, Feb 21 Session 6 – Celibacy for the Kingdom

• Tue, Apr 23 Session 7 – Marriage as a Sacrament & The Language of Sexual Love

Basic Format:

Watch video (~ 30 min.), answer study questions in small groups, then large group discussion.

NOTE:

This study is meant to help you gain an understanding of what Theology of the Body is and what it teaches us about being human, made in the image and likeness of God. Once we really get into TOB it is easy to see that if we can successfully adopt these themes and ideas as an integral part of our school culture, we could expect to see a positive, loving, Christian morality grow in our school and hopefully decrease bullying and other negative behaviors.

This starts with US – don't just learn about TOB, live it – allow the Holy Spirit to change you as a spouse, a mother, a friend, a co-worker, and a woman/man. This world / our society, wants to shove out morality and Jesus, the Truth. It is up to US as believers in the Truth (Jesus) to be what God intended for us to be – His faithful, loving servants.

Lastly – allow the Holy Spirit's fire to course through you – become . . . Fired Up for Christ!
